Disputed plots of Kazakhstan-Kyrgyzstan border could be conditionally divided into the following 5 categories:

1. From the meeting point between the state borders of the Republic of Kazakhstan, the People's Republic of China and the Kyrgyz Republic to the joint between the Kyrgyz-Kazakh border and the border between Issyk-Kul and Chuy regions of the Kyrgyz Republic.

2. From junction point of the Kyrgyz-Kazakh border between the Issyk-Kul and Chuy regions of the Kyrgyz Republic to the meeting point between the Kyrgyz-Kazakh border and the border between Almaty and Zhambyl regions of the Republic of Kazakhstan.

3. From the meeting point between Kyrgyz-Kazakhstan border with the border between Almaty and Zhambyl regions of the Republic of Kazakhstan to the point of junction of Kyrgyz-Kazakhstan frontier and the border between Chuy and Talass regions of Kyrgyz Republic.

4. From the joint of Kyrgyz-Kazakhstan border and border between Chuy and Talass regions of Kyrgyz Republic to the meeting point between Kyrgyz-Kazakhstan border and the border between Zhambyl and South-Kazakhstan regions of the Republic of Kazakhstan.

5. From the meeting point between Kyrgyz-Kazakhstan border and the border between Zhambyl and South-Kazakhstan regions of the Republic of Kazakhstan to the joint of the borders of the Kyrgyz Republic, the Republic of Kazakhstan and the Republic of Uzbekistan.
